## NIS2 Scope & Baseline Report

Sara,

You filled the intake on 2026-05-25 because two of your customers (a regional hospital and a municipal IT department) sent you security questionnaires that mention the Network and Information Security Directive (NIS2). You wanted to know three things:

1. Are you in NIS2 scope?
2. At what level?
3. What do you actually need to do?

Short answers, with the full reasoning in the sections that follow:

1. **No, not directly.** You are not an "essential" or "important" entity under the Belgian transposition of NIS2 (Law of 26 April 2024). Your self-classification as a "digital provider" does not match the narrow Annex II definition.
2. **N/A directly. CyberFundamentals (CyFun) BASIC is the recommended baseline indirectly,** because your customers are NIS2-essential entities (hospital, government) and they will push compliance requirements onto you via contract.
3. **The 34 BASIC controls in the Centre for Cybersecurity Belgium (CCB) CyberFundamentals 2025 framework, prioritized into 30/90/180-day buckets.** Full list in section 5 of the paid report.

You did not need an external auditor for this question. You needed a clear written read so you can stop guessing and start working. That is what this report provides.

What this report does *not* do: it does not implement the controls, it does not negotiate with your customers on your behalf, it is not legal advice. A law firm gives you a formal legal opinion. A Conformity Assessment Body (CAB) auditor performs CyFun audits. We sit between those: a fast, written, defensible scope read for €395.

## 1. Executive summary

In direct NIS2 scope?	<b>OUT OF SCOPE</b> Not an essential or important entity under Belgian NIS2.
Why not?	Not a "digital provider" under the strict Annex II definition; not in any other Annex I or II sector.
Indirect scope via supply chain?	<b>YES</b> Customers include NIS2-essential entities (hospital, government). NIS2 requires them to manage their supply chain. You are part of that supply chain.
Recommended baseline?	<b>CyFun 2025 BASIC</b> (34 controls). Framework Belgian customers recognise and accept as evidence.
Estimated effort to reach BASIC?	<b>80 to 120 hours over 6 months</b> for a firm of your size, assuming an IT partner does the heavy work and internal staff contribute 1 to 2 hours per week.
Time pressure?	<b>6 to 9 months.</b> No regulatory deadline applies to you directly. Customer-questionnaire deadlines (30 to 60 days each) will keep coming. The longer you wait, the more questionnaires you answer ad-hoc.
What to send the hospital and the municipal IT department right now?	A one-paragraph statement of intent committing to CyFun BASIC by Q1 2027, plus the in-progress controls you can already demonstrate. Template in section 6 of the paid report.
